



- Raffle means the award of one or more prizes by chance at a single occasion among a single pool or group of persons who have paid or promised a thing of value for a ticket that represents a chance to win.

Charitable Immunity & Liability Act

- Immunity protection for volunteers
- Limitation on liability for acts & omissions of the organization -\$500K per person, \$1 million per occurrence for bodily injury, and \$100K per occurrence for property damage
- Applies as long as liability insurance maintained
- Limitations do not apply to willful or intentional acts
