



• Six courses, offered online in an asynchronous format:

Collaboration

- Four week courses that are self paced with weekly deadlines
- Optional weekly check-ins over Zoom to connect in real time with instructors and peers from across the country
- There is a "flex" week between each course
- Entire program can be completed in about 7.5 months.

- Prerequisite must be a member in good standing with NAEF and maintain active membership to retain certification.
- Your TEFN membership pays for your NAEF membership
- If you are no longer employed with a foundation but want to keep your certification, annual membership cost for NAEF is \$175 annually.

- Cost is \$3,000. You have two options to pay:
 - Pay in full and receive a 10% discount (\$2,700)
 - Pay \$500 for each course as you go
- Next full program runs from April 23rd and concludes November 19th.
- Registration for next course closes April 16, 2023.

Does it Pay to Become Certified?



 Looking back to data from 1981, there is a strong correlation between CFRE certification and increased salary potential

 Fundraisers earn on average 5-16% more than non-certified colleagues with comparable experience.

Part 1: Application

Document information in three categories:

(must be within the past 5 years except for degrees received)

Education

- Teaching or attending continuing education
- Authoring articles/books
- Academic degrees



Professional Practice

Must be or have been employed full-time for a min. of 3 yrs. as a professional member
of a fundraising staff or as a fundraising consultant to nonprofit organizations; at least
50% of their job duties and responsibilities must consist of fundraising activities,
resource development, and/or the management of fund development


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Professional Performance

- Actual funds raised
- Communications projects
- Management projects

Part 2: The Exam

- 1. Submit application & Get Testing Window
 - Example: Application Deadline April 15 with Testing Dates April 15 – June 15
- 2. Pay Fee
 - \$875 for exam
- 3. Study! Study! Study!



CFRE Content Areas of Exam

Domain 1: Current and Prospective Donor Research (14%–28 items)

Domain 2: Securing the Gift (23%–46 items)

Domain 3: Relationship Building (26%–52 items)

Domain 4: Volunteer Involvement (8%–16 items)

Domain 5: Leadership and Management (19%–38 items)

Domain 6: Ethics, Accountability, and Professionalism (10%–20 items)
